# UPad



Ability to write on any file that is in .pdf format! Very similar to writing by hand when using a stylus.

Use for:

- EDM Math Master/journal/Skill Links
- Graphic organizers
- Lesson plans

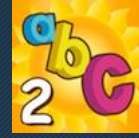

# Spelling Magic!

## Sentence Magic



Spelling Magic focuses on the skill of learning to spell words with three phonetic sounds with short vowel words. Students practice pushing the sounds into boxes. Sentence Magic helps students read words, sentences and build sentences. The first mode is sentence building where children can move the words into their correct sentence position. The second mode is the reading mode where children can read the words of the phrase or sentence and then check their work by touching the hidden picture.



# Spelling Bug



Application presents each word by displaying a picture and pronounces the word and presents the letters that are needed to make the word. Kids use their hands to arrange the letters in the right order to make the word.



# Spell Blocks



Students will learn over 200 Dolch Sight Words by spelling each one after it is spoken to them.

Spell Blocks says the word and offers the scrambled letter choices for them to choose from. Your child then touches and moves each letter to the correct place.



# Alpha Robots



Match the upper and lowercase alphabet letters to clear the board. The letters are all designed with a nice robotic theme and letter pronunciation occurs when a match is made. This is a great game for your younger children or children or adults who are learning English at an older age.



# Magnetic ABC



Students touch magnetic letters and move them around on the screen. Use just as you would with magnetic letters in your room.
